Why Hamburg is Ideal for CHC Participants

Opportunity

- If you move to the Town of Hamburg, you can be eligible to receive a larger security deposit grant as well as moving assistance with a total value of \$1,000.
- Hamburg has great schools, many employment opportunities, and continued education programs.

Quality of Life

- Hamburg is home to over 60,000 people and has many great stores, restaurants, and churches.
- Hamburg is the site of the Erie County Fair each summer.
- Hamburg is among the safest communities in WNY.

Access

- Source of income discrimination is illegal in Hamburg, so your Section 8 voucher cannot be denied.
- Hamburg's public transportation links it to Buffalo, Lackawanna, and the Southtowns.
- Your Section 8 agency may approve a higher rent voucher amount to live in Hamburg.



ELIGIBILITY

HOME's Greater Buffalo Community Housing Center provides housing search assistance and security deposit grants to Section 8 recipients coming off the housing voucher list, or other qualified housing assistance recipients. Participants can move from a current residence within a high poverty census tract to an area with less poverty and better opportunities.
